LIFE Gerontology Committee Update

Your Gerontology Committee is already working, getting ready for what it is hoped will be the receipt of a far greater number of applications than it had last year. The Board has budgeted \$29,500 to be distributed through the Richard Tucker Gerontology Research Award program to as many proposals as can be funded. But since not all the funds from 2022 were allocated, it may be possible to increase that amount if there are worthy candidates.

LIFE established the Gerontology Research Grant program to create more of this type of research by the UCF faculty. Over the past ten years, LIFE has helped researchers in almost 20 different departments, however the last two years have seen a significant decrease in applications.

Early in November an email was sent from our University Liaison officer, Dr. Wayne Bowen, to all appropriate departments informing them of the grant program and reminding them of the February deadline for submission. The next step involves visiting a number of departments to further promote this program.

Dr. Tucker himself, Ray Jones, the past chairman of the Gerontology Committee, and Bill Myers, the current chair, will make up a visitation coordinating committee. An analysis of the grants given out over the past ten (10) years has revealed several anomalies. For example, The College of Nursing, strong supporter of LIFE and a department in which several of our members volunteer, has received six grants over the past ten years, but only one since 2020, and received only one in that year.

The Psychology Department, home to Dr. Tucker, has received 10 awards overall, but only one each the past several years. The Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders has not had an award since 2018.

Hopefully our efforts will result in a large number of applications this February. We would like to see more projects like these: "Development of a Falls Prevention Program for Older Adults" (College of Nursing, 2017), "Eosinophils role on chronic inflammation and pancreatic cancer" (Burnett School of Biomedical Sciences, 2016), and "Brain Dynamics of Walking in Older Adults" (Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering, 2017). Even if there may not be enough money to support every request, what a nice realization it would be to know that so many UCF researchers are working in this important field.

Certainly, the interruption of normalcy by the Covid disease may well be the cause of LIFE having had only four (4) applications last February. Even so, LIFE is committed to fund research into issues that affect older people, and the financial support provided will help all senior citizens and their caretakers have a better, healthier life. So, if any member has an in with a department and/or knows of research projects that focus on gerontology and could use some help, please let us know.
